

# The FCC National Do Not Call Registry

The Federal Communications Commission established a national Do-Not-Call Registry. The registry is nationwide in scope, applies to all telemarketers (with the exception of certain non-profit organizations), and covers both interstate and intrastate telemarketing calls. Commercial telemarketers are not allowed to call you if your number is on the registry. This means that you, as a consumer, if you choose, can reduce the number of unwanted phone calls to your residence.

You can register on-line for the national do-not-call registry at <http://www.donotcall.gov> or by calling 1-888-382-1222; for TTY call 1-866-290-4236. You must call from the phone number you wish to register. You may register your residential telephone number, including wireless numbers, on the national Do-Not-Call registry by telephone or by Internet at no cost.

Your phone number will remain on the national do-not-call list for five years. You may re-enter your number onto the list when the five years have passed, and you may remove your name from the list at any time.
